



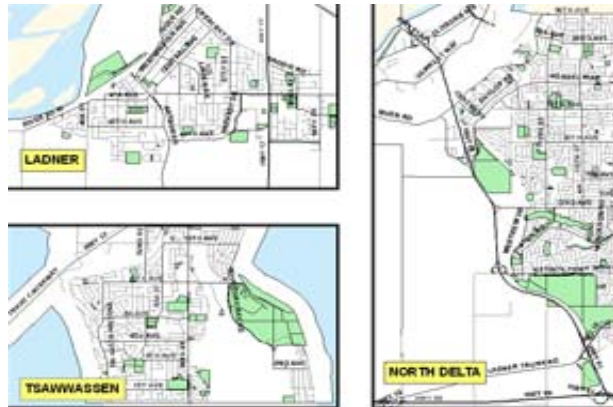

North Delta

Robbery

During the month of August there were three robberies reported in North Delta. There was one reported incident that involved youths. A group of youths surrounded a male and stole a backpack and a can of pop from the victim. This file is still under investigation.

The other reported robberies involved files where the victim and the suspect both knew each other and charges have been laid with regards to those files.

Break and Enter Commercial

A total of seventeen commercial break and enter incidents were reported in North Delta in August 2011. Several businesses were targeted along the Scott Rd Corridor. In several of the reports the front door lock of the business was either pried or punched and entry was gained. The suspect(s) stole cash from the till. The Delta Police have made an arrest on this file.

Monthly Crime Bulletin (August 2011)

Industrial Area

During the month of August there was one reported commercial break-in and one report of an attempt theft of vehicle in the industrial area in North Delta.

File#1: suspect(s) gained entrance to a compound by cutting the fence and pried open a storage box which was on a customer's truck. Several tools were stolen.

File#2: suspect(s) attempted to steal a Hino truck. There was damage to the driver side door lock and steering column.

Break and Enter Residential/Other/ Seasonal

In August 2011 there were a total of nine residential break and enter incidents reported in North Delta. In several of the reported break and enters entry was gained by kicking in the front door and electronics were stolen. The Delta Police have made an arrest with regards to these residential break-ins.

Theft of Vehicle

During the month of August a total of 8 vehicles were reported stolen in North Delta. This is a significant decrease from the previous month. Vehicles were stolen by punching the ignition and/or defeating the steering column. The majority of the vehicles were stolen overnight or early in the morning from residential areas. Vehicles were recovered in Surrey and Vancouver.

Theft from Vehicle

A total of 40 vehicles were broken into in North Delta in August 2011. Forcible entry was used in most cases and the method of operation was by punching the driver's side door lock or smashing the side window. Items stolen had varied considerably and included the following: wallets, purses, Identification, GPS systems, credit cards and other miscellaneous items.

SOUTH DELTA – Ladner & Tsawwassen

Robbery

There were no reported robberies in South Delta for the month of August.

Break and Enter Commercial

A total of five commercial break and enter incidents were reported in Ladner during the month of August, and five commercial break and enter reported in Tsawwassen.

An underground parkade was broken into twice during the month of August, in the first incident suspect(s) entered the parkade and stole a garage door opener and a set of golf clubs from a vehicle. Two weeks after the first incident another report was made where unknown person(s) bent the aluminum bars on the parking garage entrance gate.

In another report an unknown male and unknown female used a pry bar to gain access to the chain linked storage area; two large industrial batteries were stolen.

Industrial Area

During the month of August there was one reported commercial break-ins in the industrial area in Ladner.

File#1: suspect(s) broke into a storage yard; entry was gained by grinding off the lock from the gate. Approximately \$500 in scrap steel was stolen.

Break and Enter Residential/Other/ Seasonal

In August there were a total of five reported residential break and enter incidents in Ladner and Tsawwassen. In one incident suspect(s) attempted to enter the residence through an insecure kitchen window, no entry was gained. In another incident an insecure barn was entered. Suspect(s) stole keys to a forklift and a Dodge Ram as well as a pressure washer. There were two reported break-ins to an underground storage locker; in one incident a Kona bicycle was stolen.

Theft of Vehicle

There were five reported thefts of vehicles and four attempt thefts of vehicles in South Delta in August 2011. One vehicle has been recovered in Surrey. Delta Police have arrested one individual with regards to these thefts.

Theft from Vehicle

A total of 32 vehicles were broken into in Ladner and Tsawwassen in August 2011. Several of the vehicles had property in plain view and the vehicle was left insecure. Police are reminding the public to remove personal items from vehicles and to ensure that the vehicles are locked.

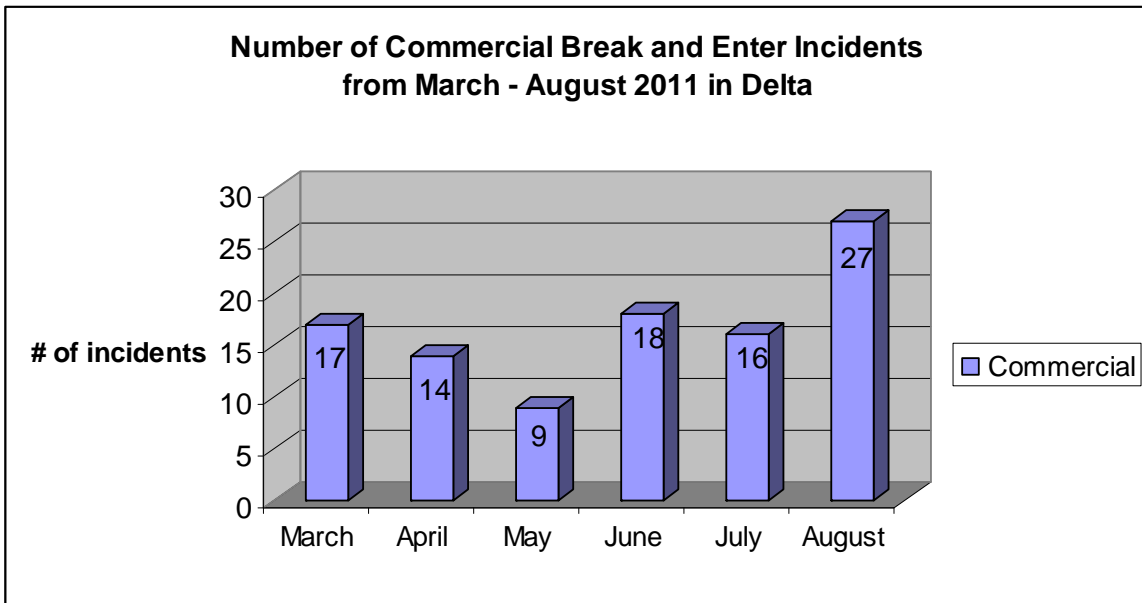
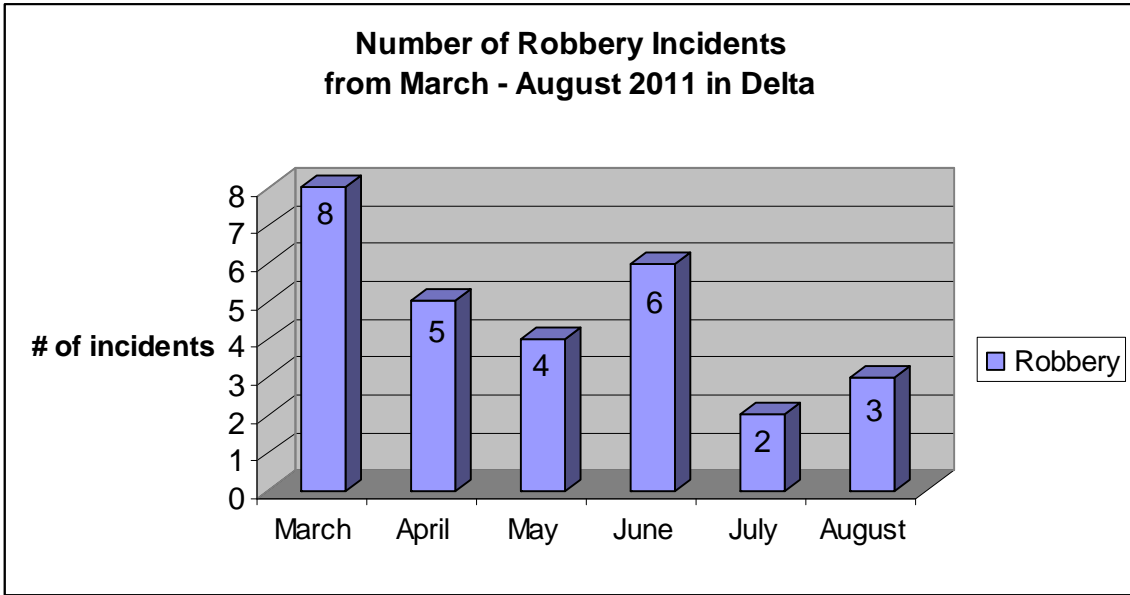
