### Delta Police Gearing up for Police Week May 12 to 15, 2010

The Delta Police will be hosting many events throughout Police Week, including Mall displays, and Open House(s) at the Community Police stations. The exhibition is dedicated to increasing community awareness through various crime prevention programs and strengthening community-police ties.

We invite the public to attend any one of the events and take advantage of becoming better acquainted with police officers, services provided by the Delta Police Department and the many Community Programs in place that enhance public safety.

**Police week is governed by four specific objectives:**

- To act as a vehicle in which to reinforce ties with the community;
- To honour police officers for the public safety and security they provide to their communities;
- To promote the work police do in their communities;  
To inform the community about the police role in public safety and security.

There will be activities in Ladner and North Delta.

**Ladner/Tsawwassen Schedule of Events:**

- **Wednesday May 12, 2010** – Open House (10 am to 4 pm) held at Ladner CoPS will be setting up a sidewalk table and display outside of their office. Free Police Week cake will be served, Child ID Program will be available, volunteer recruitment will be emphasized, and balloons will be handed out. The Ladner CoPS Volunteer Van and a marked police vehicle will be available for viewing. Safety Bear will make an appearance in the Ladner Village area.
- CoPS Volunteers will be conducting high profile “**Lock it or Lose it**” walk-through campaigns in the Trennant Park Square & Ladner Centre Mall parking lots and walkways.
- CoPS volunteers will be conducting multiple foot patrols through the Ladner Village area encouraging the public and shopkeepers to visit and utilize the Ladner CoPS Programs and services. Pamphlets and information will be provided.

**North Delta Schedule of Events:**

**Static displays will be set up at the Scottsdale Center Mall from Wednesday May 13 to Saturday May 15**
