Arrest in sexual assault investigation -Delta Police question if there may be other victims

Charges have been secured, against Jamieson, Richard GLENDINNING 60 yrs of Vancouver, as a result of an investigation conducted by the Sexual Offences Section of the Delta Police Department

The Delta Police received information in December of 2009 regarding alleged incidents of sexual assault that occurred years previous. The victims were both male and female and were elementary to high school age range.

As a result of this information received an investigation was initiated which subsequently lead to the arrest of Mr. GLENDINNING September 02 2010. Mr. GLENDINNING has made his first court appearance and was released on conditions. He is due to return to court on September 16, 2010. Charges include indecent assault, sexual assault and gross indecency.

The Delta Police are aware of and respect the publication ban that is in place. However, the circumstances learned as a result of the investigation lead police to suspect that there may potentially be other victims who have not yet come forward. One of the issues of concern is Mr. GLENDINNING's affiliation with the Tsawwassen Amateur Baseball Association between the years of 1985-1995 and that he would have had access to numerous young people at that time.
