

Criminal Records Check Results Leaving Canada: Canadian Police Certificates

Some individuals may require a Police Certificate for travel visa applications, foreign study or work permits. Others may require this for foreign employment or volunteer opportunities (\$100 fee).

Police Clearance/Police Certificate may also be required for Canadian Immigration purposes, such as Permanent Residency or Canadian citizenship applications (\$75 fee).

The Delta Police Department does not offer “Conviction Only Check” certificate. Instead, we can assist you in obtaining a **Certified Criminal Record Check (CCRC) via fingerprinting** for any requests relating to Canadian Police Certificates. We will take your fingerprints and submit them to Ottawa RCMP. Ottawa RCMP will do a name, date of birth and fingerprint based search and mail the results directly back to you. The product you receive in the mail from the RCMP in Ottawa is the CCRC and comes on RCMP letterhead with an embossed seal. This is the best option as many foreign embassies and agencies require a fingerprint based check.

Please call us at 604-946-4411 and ask to schedule a fingerprinting appointment for a CCRC. Our staff will be able to assist you further. You will be required to bring two pieces of government issued ID, one with your picture, for your appointment. We may also be able to assist walk-ins but appointments are recommended.

Note: Vulnerable Sector screening cannot be processed as part of a Police Certificate and for any results leaving Canada as it is prohibited by the Criminal Records Act.
