STUDENT POLICE ACADEMY Instructions to Applicant

The Academy provides Grade 11 and 12 students a unique opportunity to learn about the application process, training and a career in law enforcement. This program is designed for approximately 28 students who are interested in police work as a possible future career.

The students apply to the Academy through their school counselor or school liaison officer by submitting a copy of their completed application package. The packages are then forwarded to the Delta Police Department and the applicants will then be part of the selection process involving:

- a physical test-2.4 kilometer run in under 13 minutes (equivalent to six laps of a 400 meter track)
- a background check
- interview

Once this has been completed, the successful applicants will pay a tuition fee of \$200.00 (cash or cheque) that is non-refundable and all materials and uniforms will be supplied. Fees are due only after the successful applicants have received their acceptance letter from the Delta Police Department.

For those students/families experiencing financial hardship, please speak to your counselor for confidential financial assistance

The students in the Student Police Academy will learn about:

- Policing as a career
- . Use of force
- . Interpersonal Communication and De-escalation
- . Firearms training
- . Physical training
- . Scenarios
- Criminal and traffic law studies
- . Problem solving

The Academy will run for 8 days from Tuesday July 4th to Friday July 7th, 2023 - Monday July 10th to Wednesday July 12th, 2023 (0800-1600) and graduation Thursday July 13th afternoon/evening. It is an excellent learning experience but will be extremely challenging both mentally and physically. The focus will be on teamwork, confidence building and teaching youth about what a career as a police officer requires.

April 19, 2023 - Physical Test -2.4 kilometer timed run will be conducted to establish participant's baseline fitness levels. Many aspects of the Delta Police Student Police Academy entail a physical component and to ensure that participants are well placed to succeed a certain basic level of fitness is necessary. By conducting the timed run in the Spring applicants with borderline fitness levels are afforded sufficient time to engage in a fitness regime to prepare for the SPA in July. 2.4 km is the equivalent of 6 laps of a 400 m track. Applicants should aim for a time of under 13 minutes to complete the run. Goal is to improve fitness level to ensure best experience.

Parental Waiver, Release of Liability, Indemnification and Consent Form

I, the undersigned, as the parent or legal guardian of the child named below, do hereby give my full consent and approval for my child to participate in the Delta Police Student Police Academy (referred to hereafter as the "Academy").

I understand that the very nature of the Academy is hazardous and risky. I understand that there are certain risks of bodily injury, death or property damage that may occur during or as a result of participation in the Academy. I agree to assume all of these risks on behalf of my child. These risks include, but are not limited to, those hazards associated with other participants, volunteers, instructors, equipment, my child's health condition(s), and others not known to me.

Further, I agree that in consideration for the right to allow my child to participate in the Academy:

- 1. On behalf of my child and myself, I do voluntarily elect to accept and solely assume all risks of damage, theft and/or injury incurred or suffered by my child: (a) while participating in the Academy; (b) while observing others participate in the Academy; and (c) while at the locations, or on or upon the premises, or travelling between the same, as arranged for performance of the Academy.
- 2. In addition to giving my full consent for my child's participation, I do hereby waive, release, discharge and agree not to sue the City of Delta, the Delta Police Board, the Delta Police Department, or any members or employees of the same (referred to hereafter as the "Releasees") for any claim, damages, costs including lawyer's fees, or cause of action which I or my child have or may have in the future as a result of damages, injuries, including death, sustained or incurred by my child from whatever cause including, but not limited to, my child's conduct and/or the negligence or wrongful conduct of the Releasees.
- 3. I agree on behalf of myself and my child listed below, that I shall hold harmless and fully indemnify the Releasees from any and all claims, damages, costs including attorney fees, and causes of action which may arise from any cause of action made by me or by, through or on behalf of my child, even if the damages, injuries or death are caused in whole or in part by any of the Releasees.
